As I look to 2023 and beyond, I am optimistic that the transitions still ahead of us while challenging, will nonetheless provide the opportunity for us to continue to grow and expand our work to cultivate thriving families across our community. Thanks to every one of you who have invested in our mission, our youth, and our staff. It is your support that makes our work possible!

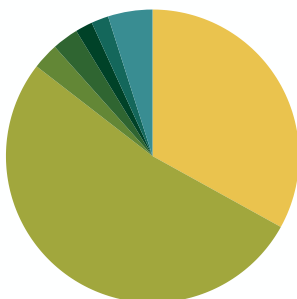

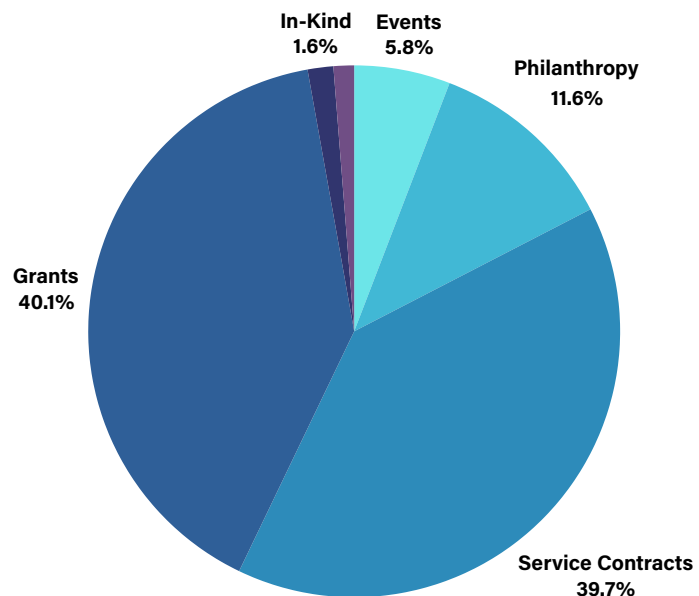

SAM'S STORY

Sargent First Class Wright of the 1050th Army National Guard of South Carolina, also known as Mr. Sam, Dietary Services Coordinator at Carolina Youth Development Center is not only a valued employee at CYDC, but also has a personal connection to our mission.

As a child, Sam and his sister entered the foster care system at a young age. They were placed in multiple foster homes and ended up being separated from each other due to conflicts within the foster homes. Sam was placed in one more foster home before being placed in a group home in Georgetown.

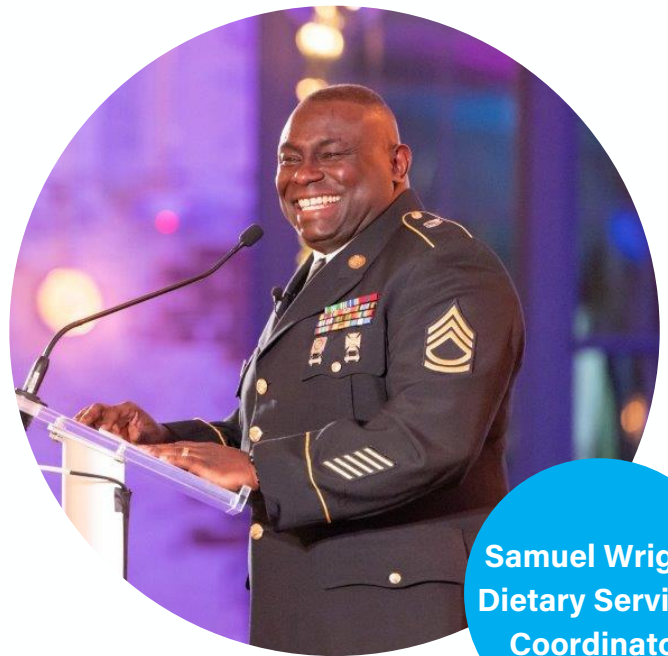
As time progressed, Sam was given the opportunity to move closer to his sister and was placed at the Charleston Orphan House, now known as Carolina Youth Development Center. During his time at CYDC, Sam was able to grow and develop, learned coping mechanisms to better manage his emotions, and received the support services needed for life as an adult.

"I had great family teachers that would teach me different life skills and encourage me to use those skills each day."

After living at CYDC for eighteen months, Sam was reunited with his mother. He attended Garrett High School where he was involved in ROTC for all 4 years and was in the 1991 graduating class.

After high school, Sam entered the Marine Corps where he had the opportunity to travel the world serving as a Mortarman. In 2007, Sam joined the Army National Guard and is still serving today. After 26 years with the United States Military, Sam came back to CYDC as the Dietary Services Coordinator.

Everyday, Sam ensures that the youth on both campuses have well balanced meals for breakfast, lunch, and dinner. But he does so much more than that. He is a friend and mentor to the youth and provides real-life experience that is relatable to our current residents. We are grateful to once again have Sam as part of the CYDC family!

STRENGTHENING FAMILIES

The Strengthening Families Program serves families with children ages 6 to 16. The program is designed to help families develop positive discipline practices, stay resilient in tough times, reduce conflict, improve parenting skills, and assist children with social skills, relationships, and school performance.

In 2022, 94 children and adults graduated from the Strengthening Families Program. During the 14-week program, parents expressed that they were so appreciative of the staff and excited that they could finally get the help that they needed. The teens enjoyed learning different ways to communicate with their family and liked knowing that their parents were learning the same thing, at the same time in a different room.

"I have needed this program and I'm so glad it's here. I don't know what I would do without this training." - A parent from the 6-11 age group

The program has seen great engagement and success and we look forward to serving even more youth and families in the coming year.

Trey* and Taylor* are both residents in NuHouse, our transitional housing program. They came to CYDC because of different life circumstances, but since being here, have seen great success and look to have bright futures.

Taylor has been at CYDC for just under a year. Since coming to CYDC, Taylor has enrolled in online school and secured a part-time job. She has learned the importance of education and how to earn and save money. She is working towards getting her own apartment and car and has a dream of owning a pink jeep wrangler.

While at CYDC, Trey completed his GED and enrolled in Trident Technical College. He saved up enough money to buy his first car and has been taking the time to learn how he can work on his car himself using the Cummins Auto Lab located on our campus. Trey completed his first two college courses with A's and spent his winter break working, saving up money, and preparing for his next round of college courses. Many of the other residents look up to Trey and he often gives the younger residents guidance on how to maximize their time while at CYDC.

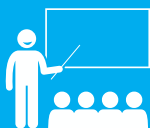
